Foraker Named to Beaver Water District Board Position



The Beaver Water District Board of Directors voted at its monthly meeting on April 21 to name Cathy Foraker of Fayetteville to fill the unexpired term of Director Mary Beth Brooks of Fayetteville. Brooks, who has served on the board since 2007, resigned her position on the board on March 30.

Foraker is the Director- External Affairs for AT&T. A graduate of the University of Arkansas, she serves as a liaison between elected officials and AT&T. She is a member of the Board of Directors for Arvest Bank in Fayetteville and represents AT&T on the Northwest Arkansas Council. Foraker is Past President and a current Board member of the Fayetteville Chamber of Commerce, serves as Chair-Elect for the Rogers-Lowell Area Chamber of Commerce, and serves on the Board of Rebuilding Together of Northwest Arkansas. She is a member of the Downtown Fayetteville Rotary Club and serves on the Northwest Advisory Board for the Nature Conservancy, the Board of Directors for the Symphony of Northwest Arkansas, the Fayetteville Public Education Foundation, and the Board of Directors for the Arkansas Single Parent Scholarship Fund.
